Lesotho

God always orchestrates “divine appointments” when you are willing and available. One of those moments happened while Russ was shopping for building supplies to construct one of our church tabernacles in Lesotho. He passed a hardware store called “Nazareth” and knew he had to stop there. When he walked inside, he could hear people speaking in Arabic. (Russ’ father is a Palestinian so Russ learned Arabic as a youth.) Russ began to speak to them in Arabic. He found out they were also Palestinians from a neighboring village to his father. **In fact, their family was the only Palestinians in all of Lesotho and God made sure that Russ found them!** They were Muslim but listened as Russ shared his faith. He shared how much God loved them to send him all the way to them in the remote area of Lesotho. They then gave an invitation for our families to meet for tea one day.



Because you SEND us, we can PREACH the good news, so Lesotho can HEAR the message, BELIEVE in Jesus and CALL on His name.

How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!” **Romans 10:14-15**
